



TRUMAN SCHOOL FOR PEACE STUDIES CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Scholarships for Doctoral Students in Peace and Conflict Resolution Research with an Emphasis on the Israeli-Palestinian Conflict, the Middle East, and Jerusalem.

\$17,000 per year up to 4 years + academic support

For doctoral students who plan to study in any of the Social Sciences, Humanities, Law, Social Work, Education or Business Administration faculties and schools of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem in the 2021-22 academic year. Candidates from other fields will also be considered.

Students will share office space at the Truman Institute and will be required to spend at least three days per week there.

Students will be required to participate in intensive courses, a seminar for researchers on the subject of peace research and the advancement of peace, and in the organization of conferences and workshops in the subject matter.

The aim of this scholarship program is to create a community of outstanding doctoral students in the field of peace research and conflict resolution, and to enhance thinking in and around the field, while providing them academic support and an opportunity to focus on their research.

Deadline for Applications: January 31, 2021

Applicants must submit a CV, a cover letter, a research proposal (up to 3 pages, in English), academic transcripts, a letter of acceptance from the advisor, and two letters of recommendation.
